This letter is to acknowledge receipt of the August 16, 2000 letter to the Department of Energy (Department) from Advanced Energy Corporation, and the accompanying *Certification of Compliance with Energy Efficiency Standards for Electric Motors* from TECO Electric & Machinery Co., Ltd., dated August 10, 2000, which reports on and certifies that certain basic models of electric motors, manufactured or distributed by TECO Electric & Machinery Co., Ltd. (TECO), comply with the applicable energy efficiency requirements contained in Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 431 (10 CFR 431), *Energy Conservation Program for Certain Commercial and Industrial Equipment* and Part C of the *Energy Policy and Conservation Act*, 42 U.S.C. 6311 *et seq.*

The Department has, under section 431.123(f), *Response to Compliance Certification: Compliance Certification Number (CC number)*, of 10 CFR 431, processed the above initial Compliance Certification submitted by Advanced Energy Corporation on behalf of TECO, and finds that it satisfies the applicable requirements of section 431.123, *Compliance certification*, of 10 CFR 431. (We have not reviewed, however, the accuracy of the information in your Compliance Certification.)


The Department hereby issues the following Compliance Certification (CC) number to TECO:

As indicated on your August 10, 2000, Certification of Compliance, the above CC number is to be displayed on the applicable basic models of electric motors marked with the names "TECO" "TECO-Westinghouse Motor Company" or "TECO-Westinghouse Motors (Canada) Inc.," Furthermore, the above CC number must be displayed on the permanent nameplate of these electric motors in the form CC002A, and disclosed in marketing materials, under the provisions of section 431.82, *Labeling requirements*, of 10 CFR 431.
